Orchestra Director: Terry Foster (Recapped by Jennifer Parker, Foster not present)

- 10/17 first concert. Working on bringing in clinicians.
- LA trip is on choice and orchestra going. Waiting on airfare confirmations. Trying to get flights out of ORD instead of MDW to make it easier on transportation of students. Fundraisers in motion for trip.
- Foster suggests meeting with all directors related to soundproof door initiative. Previously, plan had been in place for the practice rooms and teacher office doors to sound proof so that more individual practice rooms are

available. Initiative stalled during pandemic, revisiting now. Money was earmarked for the doors, so we need to re-evaluate process and steps, talk to custodial staff, see if new bids are necessary, etc.

Choir Director: Jennifer Parker

Band Director: Anthony Gnutek

- In the throws of marching band, which takes up lots of time and funding. Had first competition past weekend and have done one football game. HDJMB didn't place at competition, missed by fraction of percentage. Team worked hard at Monday's rehearsal to come back from it.

Guitar Director: Chad Bobik

- Guitar Ensemble underway. Starting electric guitar club. Initiating morning club "jam sessions" to encourage involvement and collaboration. Also doing open mic type activities after school.
- Jacobs hosting "Battle of the Bands" in January. First time in several years. Want to get the word out it's for all three high schools on 1/17/2025. Trying to build music community at Jacobs (Devona suggests providing a flyer to orchestra, choir, and band leaders to share with their students).
- Guitar Ensemble 7 pm concert, open mic before that.
- Have not sent out uniform information yet. Olivia Wood doing merch design.

Orchestra VP: Jenny Clark Moran

Introduced self. New to Jacobs. Daughter is freshman violin. New VP. Nothing to report yet.

Band VP: Amy Moran

- Introduced self. Marching band underway. Learning how to load and unload trucks for competitions. Cart broke last weekend, working on fixing it.
- 50/50 raffle needs volunteers. Last came was \$214 in fundraising, down from previous. To increase, we need more people to assist some games have none scheduled. Noted that there may be an increase to dry cleaning bill for uniforms due to new choreography involving dance moves on the grass.

- Fundraisers lined up for CA trip. Have thoughts on general fundraising ideas. We need to generate more. Right now, only doing Tag Day/QR code, 50/50 raffle, and craft fair. Should be looking for more options.

Craft Fair Chairs: Amy Dempsey and Mini Varghese

- First year chairing craft fair event. Any and all feedback and help welcome. 11/2 is craft fair. 65 booths reserved, but had 95 last year so aiming to meet or exceed that number. 57 applications submitted thus far, 52 have paid. Note that Mr. Foster does the student volunteer sign ups (Tri-m for service hours).
- Need to contact Mr. Budnyk for tape to outline booths. Have the binder from the person who did it last year.
 Going through everything Need to plan concessions and get the info. Need donations for donuts, etc. Booster president has to sign. President Arlene also confirmed that spirit wear gets set up in the hall outside the library on craft fair day.
- Gnutek asked for a flyer/link to get sign ups. Co-chair Amy asked if anyone had a sample from last year they
 could use as reference. Craft fair supplies stored in choir closet per Devona.
- ILMEA Jazz also on 11/2, per Parker, which could impact some student participation.
- Parker advised that new owner of "Nothing Bundt Cakes" reached out about collaborating. Devona advised had contacted new ownership several times with no response. Parker will provide info for follow up.
